

## Park City Reading Endorsement

### Program Logistics:

**7 courses: Master's level—work outside of classroom and regular attendance are required**

- Reading Comprehension Instruction
- Instructional Implications of Literacy Development
- Instruction with Literature and Informational Text for Children and Young Adults
- Effective Writing Instruction
- Content Area Reading and Writing Instruction
- Reading Assessments and Instructional Interventions
- Foundations of Literacy Instruction

**\*\*Approval for out-of state and/or online coursework will be determined by USOE**

**3 Cohorts—maximum of 25 students in each:**

- January 6, 2016-June 30, 2017
- September, 2017-mid June, 2018
- September, 2018-mid-June, 2019

**\*\* District expectation is for all K-3 teachers to have earned their endorsement by EOY 2020**

### **Enrollment and Cost of the Courses**

- Preference for course enrollment will be given to **current** K-3 Park City teachers
- Second preference will be given to 4-6 Park City teachers
- Any remaining slots can be filled by any 7-12 teachers
- Tuition (\$45/course) and UVU registration fee (\$35) will be paid by the district for K-3 teachers only—all others will pay those fees
- All participants will be expected to purchase course textbooks and pay for their Praxis test

### **Schedule for Cohort 1, 1<sup>st</sup> Course—Reading Comprehension**

- All classes Wednesday evenings during the school year, 4:30-7:30 at the DO, Room D
- January 6, 13, 20, 27; February 3, 10, 24; March 2, 9, 16, 23, 30; April 13, 20, 27 (first course)
- Summer courses—June 6-10 and 13-14 (6 hrs. /day—1 can be online work) and June 15—3 hrs. (second course)
- June 20-24 and 27-28 (6 hrs. /day—1 can be online work), June 29—3 hrs. (third course)
- August 31-December 14 (fourth course)
- January 4-April 26, 2017 (fifth course)
- June 12-June 21, 2017 (sixth course)
- June 22-June 30, 2017 (seventh course—completion of endorsement if all courses are complete)

### **Cohorts 2 and 3**

- Course sequence will follow similar sequence of Cohort 1

***Previous/partial endorsement credit***

- See FAQ's
- Endorsement licensing is under USOE—any credit needs to be verified by them
- Coursework must have occurred within the past 8 years to count towards this endorsement
- All coursework and grades will be verified by USOE prior to the endorsement being issued by the state
