

Dual Language Immersion Curriculum

In all Dual Language Immersion programs in K-3, students study Literacy, Science, Social Studies and Math in the target language, and Literacy and Math reinforcement in English.

From 4th-5th grade, students study Literacy/Language Arts and Science in the target language and Language Arts, Social Studies and Math in English.

In 6th grade, students study Reading/Language Arts and the Foundations of Social Studies in the target language and all other subjects in English. The curriculum is aligned to both state and national standards and students are tested in English on standardized assessments and in Spanish with the AAPPL target Language test (from www.actfl.org).
